



**Montgomery Department of Economic Development/Youth Workforce Services  
Partners with  
Maryland Division of Rehabilitation Services (DORS)  
To offer Youth Summer Employment**

The Montgomery County Department of Economic Development will have the opportunity to serve youth with disabilities this summer. With funding from DORS, DED has contracted with TransCen, a leader in working with individuals with disabilities to facilitate the Summer Program. DED currently has a contract with TransCen to serve in-school youth with disabilities

TransCen will serve 20 DORS eligible youth. Each will receive support in job search planning, placement in a summer job with a cooperating employer, and post placement support as necessary to complete 6 weeks on the job. Each participant will meet one-one with an Employment Specialist. The participant will have a customized employment plan and will receive on-going support from TransCen through out their work experience.

TransCen prides itself on the individualized attention they offer their participants and it will not be done differently this summer. TransCen has a large and dependable business base and has already recruited employers for the summer.

Youth will start work in June and end in August; with an open start date based on the youth. Each participant will have a six-week experience. Youth will work 30 hours and will be paid \$7.25 per hour.
